1. W. D. ALLEN / MANUFACTURING / COMPANY / CHICAGO ILLINOIS with image of crescent moon. (clear, cobalt, and yellowish green)
2. BABCOCK / HAND / GRENADE / NON – FREEZING / MANFD BY FIRE EXTINGUISHER MFG CO. / 325-331 DES PLAINES ST. CHICAGO. (amber, clear, and cobalt)
3. C. & N-W Ry. (Chicago & North Western Railway) (clear - tubular shaped)
4. The Hand Grenade Fire Extinguisher, Manufactured at 205 Wabash Ave., Chicago, Ill. (label only, colors unknown, information from 1884 ad)
5. HARDEN:
 - a. HARDEN'S IMPROVED - GRENADE FIRE - EXTINGUISHER PAT OCT 7TH 1884. Label reads: throw this grenade so as to break it and deliver its contents into the fire. Harden's Nest, grenade, fire, extinguisher, manufactured, at, 247, So. Canal St., Chicago, Ill. (two and three part "nest" grenades, glass vertical sections wired together by copper wire - clear and cobalt)
 - b. HARDEN'S IMPROVED HAND - GRENADE FIRE EXTINGUISHER / PATENT (Chicago*) (amber, clear, and cobalt)
 - c. "STAR" (inside circle) / HARDEN HAND GRENADE - FIRE EXTINGUISHER (Chicago*). (amber, clear, cobalt, green, and turquoise blue)
 - d. THE / HARDEN / "STAR" (inside circle) / TUBULAR / GRENADE (Chicago*) (clear and turquoise blue - tubular shaped)
 - e. HARDEN'S HAND / FIRE / EXTINGUISHER / GRENADE – PATENTED / NO. 1 / AUG 8, 1871 / AUG 14, 1883 (Chicago*). (cobalt and pale apple green)
 - f. HARDEN'S HAND / FIRE / EXTINGUISHER / GRENADE – PATENTED / NO. 2 / AUG 8, 1871 / AUG 14, 1883 (Chicago*). (cobalt)
